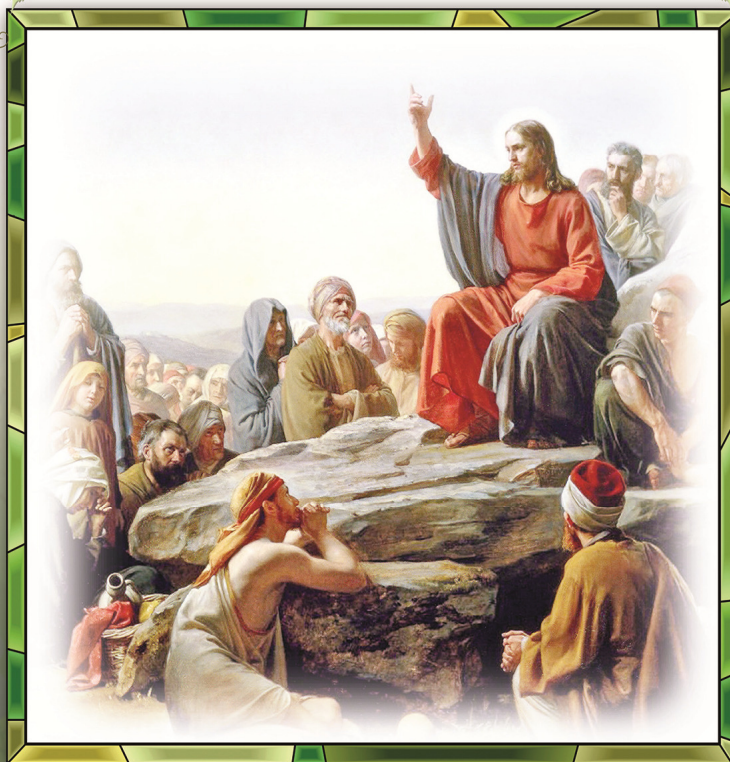

Dates: Feb. 21, 28, March 7, 21 and 28.

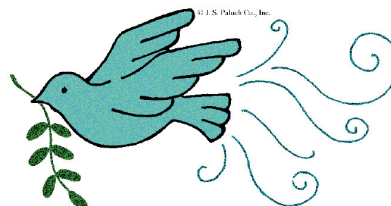

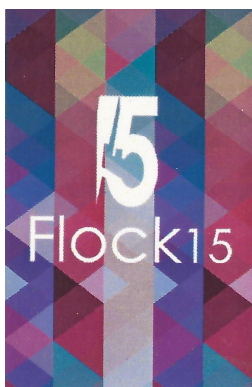
